Dear Saints of First Presbyterian Church:


The next day the great crowd that had come to the festival heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord-- the King of Israel!" John 12:12-13

Palm Sunday brings us to our feet and causes us to raise our voices with the crowds in Jerusalem that greeted Jesus upon His arrival. We wave branches and sing the "happier" hymns that have been somewhat absent during the journey of Lent. We stand alongside the crowd at the city gate with our palm branches waving, filled with expectation and hope.

But the crowd will turn on Jesus in less than a week, and in some ways we do the same in our own lives. When the hopes and expectations of Sunday are not fulfilled by Monday or Tuesday – at the latest! Jerusalem sees Jesus triumphantly come into the city and cheers His arrival, but not much time passes before Jerusalem seeks other answers. We are not so different, save that we know more of how the story ends. We'll talk about it Sunday.

Because our hope is never misplaced in Christ, know that you are loved.


