
Dear Saints of First Presbyterian Church:

Then (Jesus) called the crowd again and said to them, "Listen to me, all of you, and understand: there is nothing outside a person that by going in can defile, but the things that come out are what defile."

- Mark 7:14-15

We meet Jesus as he is expanding on a response to the Pharisees' objection that Jesus' disciples have not been performing the ceremonial washing of their hands prior to eating. For them, this is no small matter and they confront Him over the disciples eating with "defiled hands." (v.7:5) Jesus responds to their objection by explaining the real source of defilement, and His explanation confronts all of us with the truth of our own hearts. We'll talk about it Sunday.
